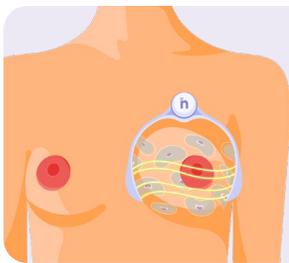
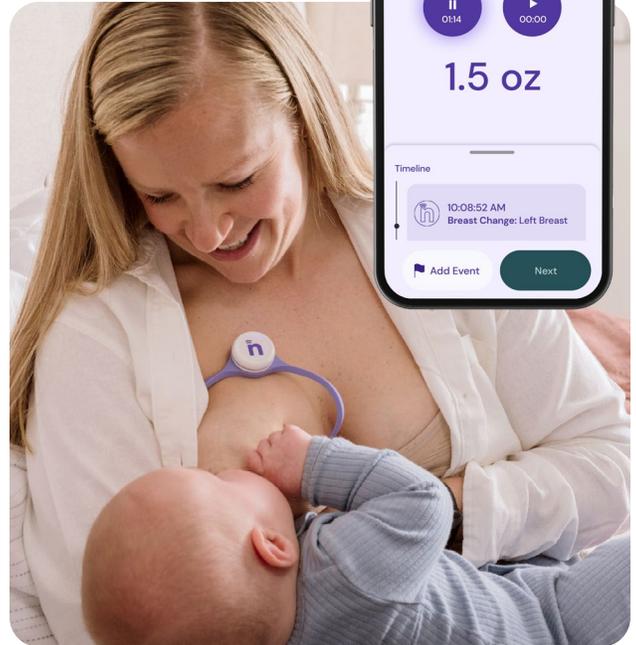
## Measuring mom's milkflow during breastfeeding

nfant<sup>®</sup> Thrive Breast measures when milk is flowing during breastfeeding (milk ejection/letdown) and how much milk flowed during a breastfeeding session (volume expression) using bioimpedance analysis. It estimates the volume of breast milk expressed by measuring the electrical resistance of the breast tissue before and after feeding.

## Use Case Example: Mom and Baby Need Sleep!



Mom wants to know how often she should feed and when her most efficient feeds are.



You have suggested the baby can go 6 hours without feeding and that she can skip the 3am feed, but mom isn't so sure she can break his scheduled feeds (every three hours).



You send Mom home and she purchases Thrive Breast and wears the device for her last feed of the day, her 3am feeding and her morning feeding session.



She reviews her feeds in the Tracker app and is able to see that while the last feeding was good and the morning feed was ample, the middle of the night feeding resulted in less than an ounce



Combined with her own interpretation of how those feeds went, Mom is able to deduce that the middle of the night feeding is no longer needed.



She also reads the related educational materials in the app for additional knowledge and confidence.
